



FEES AND INSURANCE

Providence Surgery Center charges a predetermined fee for each surgical procedure. This fee includes operating room, recovery room, nursing service, supplies and medications. This does not include the surgeon, anesthesiologist, pathology or implants. Contact your insurance provider in advance if you have any questions.

Please contact your insurance carrier:

- if your policy states that pre-authorization or certification is necessary for coverage and deductible information (what you are going to be responsible for).
- Bring in your current insurance card(s) for us to copy for your file.
- Balance is due six months from the date of service.
- Monthly payments of your choosing must be made for us to hold your account for the full six months.
- We accept: cash, local checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discovery, cashiers checks and money orders.
- We offer Care Credit as a no interest option for payment - carecredit.com.
- You will receive multiple bills for your visit.
*The surgeon, anesthesiology and pathology are billed by their own office.
- Payment for cosmetic procedures must be paid prior to surgery.
- All other self pay patients must pay 50% of estimated charges prior to surgery.
